

How to get to the ÖAR?

From Airport to Wien-Mitte (= City Centre)

The quickest and easiest way to travel from and to the Vienna International Airport (*Schwechat*) is by train. From the airport there is one direct train to **Wien-Mitte** (= Vienna city centre) station, the City Airport Train (CAT). It's non-stop and takes 16 minutes. The station is situated below the airport. Simply follow the green CAT signs.

You can find the (green) automatic ticket machines in the baggage claim area, the arrival hall, on the way to the platform and directly on the platform. A single/return ticket is 10,00 € /18,00 €.

From Wien-Mitte/Landstraße to ÖAR

At the station **Wien-Mitte/Landstraße** you change to the underground **U3** heading to *Ottakring*. A single ticket is 1,80 € and can be bought at the (red) vending machines.

Get off at **Herrengasse** station (station right after *Stephansplatz*).

From Westbahnhof railway station to ÖAR

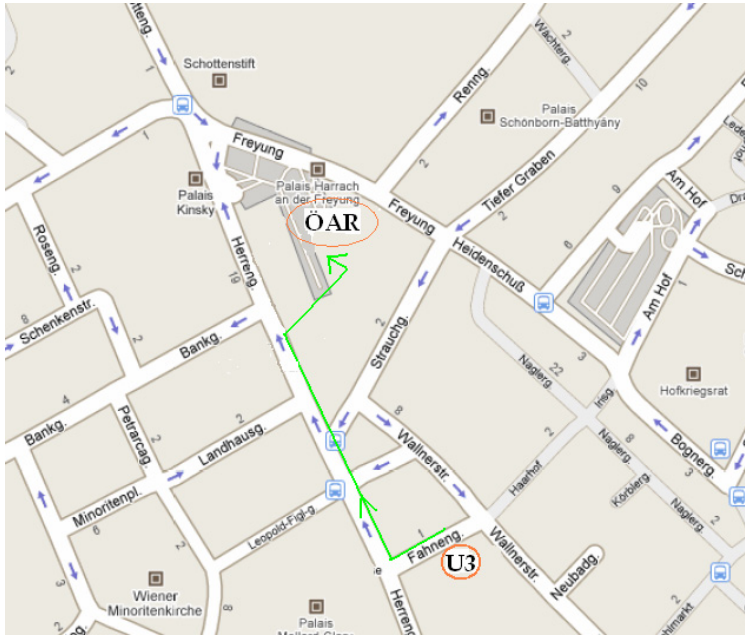
Arriving at **Westbahnhof**, simply follow the signs to the Underground U3 (heading to *Simmering*). A single ticket is 1,80 € and can be bought at the (red) vending machines.

Get off at **Herrengasse** station (station right after *Volkstheater*).

From Herrengasse station to ÖAR

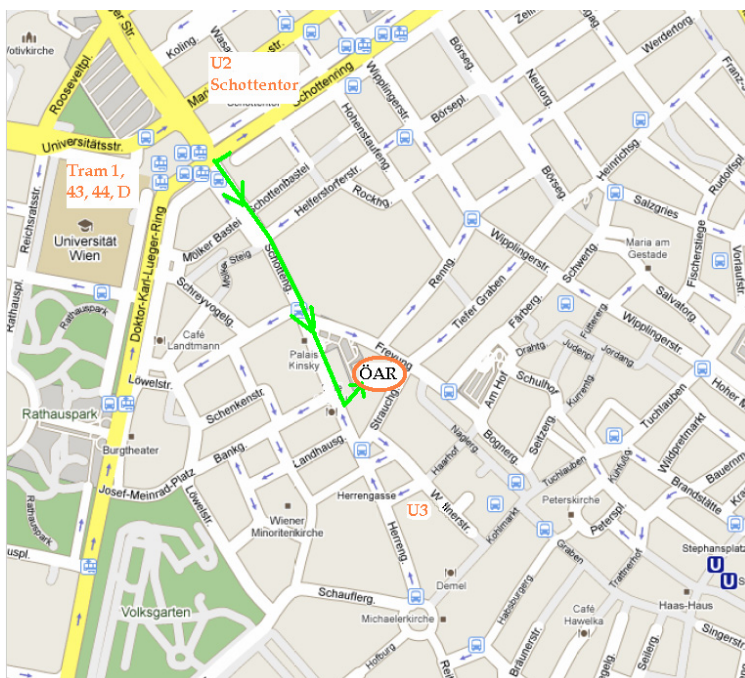
Leave the underground station (Direction: *Herrengasse*) via the escalator, bear hard round to your left and proceed to *Herrengasse*, then turn right. Go past Café Central; take the entrance to the Palais Ferstel Arcade and after ca. 30 meters turn left into a small courtyard. Now you can either use the staircase or the lift to the 2nd floor.



From Schottentor station to ÖAR

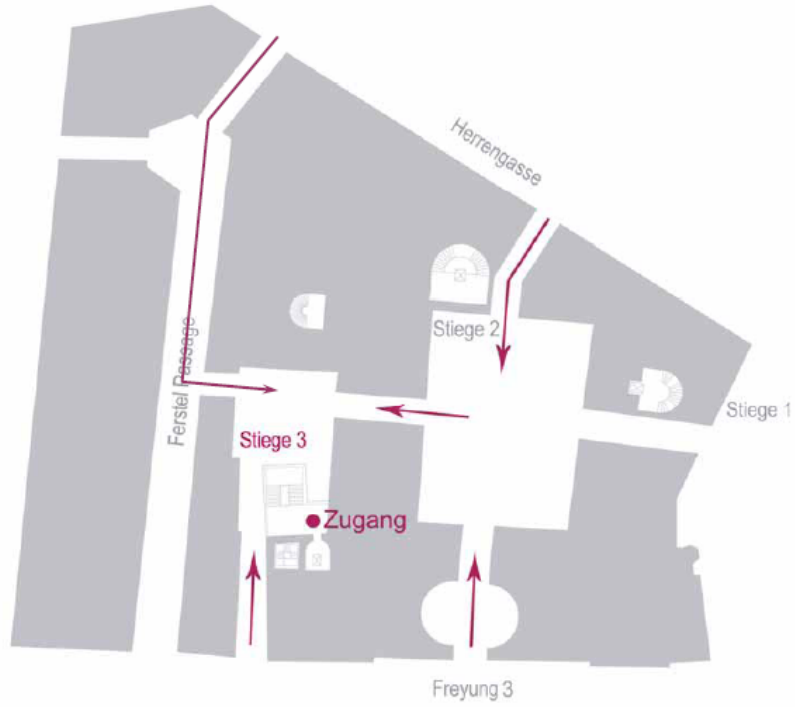
ÖAR is also accessible by the underground **U2**, get off at **Schottentor**, then walk ca. 500 metres. The tramlines 1, 43, 44, D have as well a stop at **Schottentor**. For further information, please visit
